### **DECOMMISSIONING OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS ON THE RECRUITMENT OF PRE-APPRENTICES PROCESS**

The Technical, Entrepreneurial and Vocational Education and Training (TEVET) Authority is informing the general public that, starting with the 2018 pre-apprentices recruitment process, it will no longer administer Entry examinations during the recruitment of pre-apprentices.

The purpose of decommissioning the entrance examinations which is part of the ongoing reforms being championed by government is to increase efficiency in and effectiveness of the recruitment process, mainly, through optimizing finance, time and human resources utilization which is in line with current best practices.

As such, the selection of pre-apprentices will be based on the Malawi School Certificate (MSCE) grades, Programme subject combination as per specific course requirements and equity as guided by government policies, procedures and statutes.

In this case the authority will no longer be using entrance examination grades as part of selection criteria as has been the case all along.

The General public should further note that the selection for 2018 pre – apprenticeship programme is at an advanced stage and that successful candidates who will be selected using these criteria will be duly informed through letters, SMS's and public announcements.
